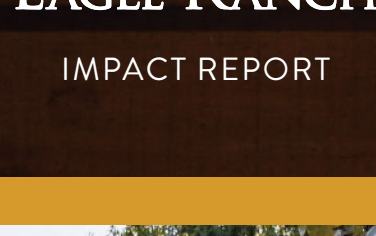

## Creating PATHWAYS TO HOPE

SINCE 1985, EAGLE RANCH HAS WALKED ALONGSIDE HURTING CHILDREN AND FAMILIES TO HELP THEM FIND A PATHWAY TO HOPE.

### The journey to healing starts with courage.

It is hard to admit that your family is struggling. It is heartbreaking to see your child acting out and unsure how to help them. Eagle Ranch has guided more than 2,000 children and families along their path to healing and a future filled with hope.

In today's challenging world, more families than ever are finding themselves in distress and in need of support. The successful introduction of outpatient counseling, retreats and nonprofit consulting through The Wings Center has affirmed the overwhelming community need for mental health and support services.

With increasing calls from families seeking help beyond residential care, Eagle Ranch began pilot programs for two new services: a Day Student Program in its on-campus school and Family Support Counseling to provide immediate access to counseling services for families in critical need.

The impact has been significant. Thanks to the confidence and faithfulness of our supporters, we are reaching more children and families than ever before.

## A NEW LOOK AT School

OUR SACS-ACCREDITED ON-CAMPUS SCHOOL SERVES GRADES 4 - 11 AND ACHIEVES HIGH LEVELS OF STUDENT SUCCESS.

The therapeutic environment tailors learning to each student's needs and provides a structured, encouraging environment. With classrooms of no more than 10 students, each child is challenged to push themselves while surrounded by support to reach new levels in academics, social skills and their ability to regulate emotions.

Eagle Ranch's work with families has demonstrated that the earlier we can help a family in their struggles, the greater the opportunity for long-term success. As calls have increased for children whose difficulties affect their school performance, we realized we had an opportunity.

IN 2022, EAGLE RANCH LAUNCHED A PILOT DAY STUDENT PROGRAM, providing a healing school environment for children and support for their families. Students do not live on campus but attend the Eagle Ranch School during the school day. Their families participate in counseling, parent groups and educational Family Insight Nights. The success of this early pilot is being expanded in 2023 to provide help for students entering the entering 4th or 5th grade. This upper elementary school program will provide early intervention for struggling students and families, giving them the help and tools they need to prevent and overcome future challenges.

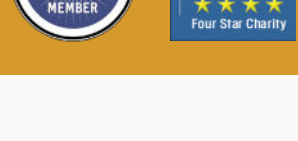

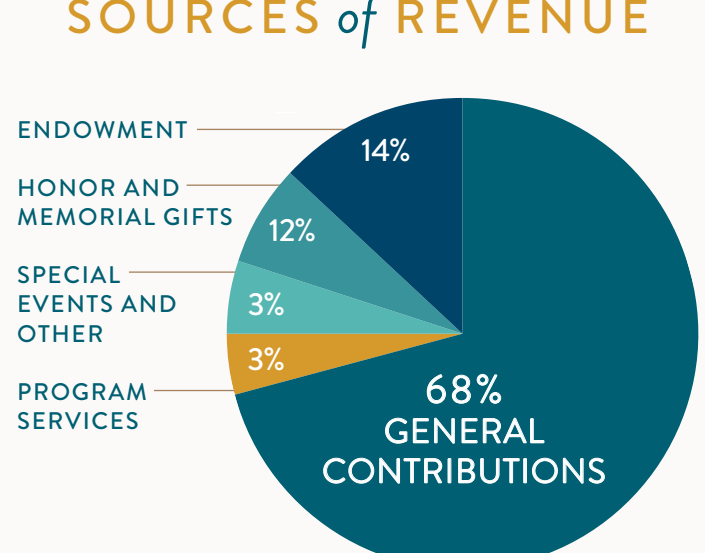
